A few pointers to help you with your visit.

- We ask that golf shoes are not to be worn in the club lounge
- Please ensure that your kit bags are left in the changing rooms – the staff will let you have the door code
- If it has been raining please change from wet clothing before coming into the Lounge
- Whilst playing golf please wear traditional golf clothing. We do not accept that denim jeans, tracksuits, vests, combat wear or flip flops are suitable for golf
- When in the clubhouse smart casual clothing is acceptable
- We would prefer that shirts are 'tucked in', unless specifically designed to be worn outside of trousers
- We welcome players wearing tailored shorts or trousers, socks of any length and colour and collared shirts
- Please follow the signage from greens to tees, especially the 2nd to the 3rd, 4th to the 5th, the 6th to the 7th and the 12th to the 13th.
- Some of our greens are near to tees, please refrain from teeing off whilst other players are 'putting out'
- If you have any queries then our staff will be happy to help you
