



Members value Mid-Herts as a friendly club with long standing traditions, and welcomes visitors to enjoy the golf course and facilities on offer. Good golfing etiquette is appreciated at all times, and members and visitors should show courtesy and respect to fellow players, staff and members of the public.

### **On The Course**

Players must wear clothing that has been designed or is recognised for golf, and not to wear unsuitable clothes such as denim jeans, tracksuits or football/ rugby shirts.

It is also important that recognised golf shoes, with approved spikes, are worn.

### **In The Clubhouse**

Players are requested to change from wet and/or dirty golfing clothes after completion of their golf especially if they intend using the dining area.

Smart clean casual attire in the Clubhouse is required except for events when formal dress has been stipulated.

### **Advice**

The following guidelines on acceptable clothing in the clubhouse are provided to assist members and visitors:-

- Plain trousers of smart denim and of a uniform colour are acceptable.
- Tailored shorts of any length are acceptable- tailored means 'with belt loops and fly'.
- All recognised golfing styles of shirt are acceptable.
- Sandals & deck shoes without socks may be worn.
- Trainers are acceptable.

BUT

- Tracksuits, hats, visors and flip-flops are not acceptable.
- Sports shorts and 'camouflage' style trousers cannot be worn.
- Football and rugby shirts, vests and tee shirts are not acceptable.
